



Emergency Communication During Facility Disruptions

It is important to keep communication open during facility disruptions, closings, and states of emergency caused by power outages and natural disasters. During these situations, you should contact your supervisor. If you are unable to do so, or need additional information, we have put together the following communication options.



Facility Status Hotline – (800) 301-0595

This toll-free number provides up to date information about facility status. Please keep this number available and check it during facility disruptions



Mass Text Service – via Remind

Whirlwind has signed up for a text messaging service that allows the Whirlwind admins to send a mass text message to everyone that signs up. One-way text messages (you cannot reply to them) will only be sent out when Whirlwind admins feel it is necessary to send out an urgent message. Signing up for this service is free but standard messaging rates apply for all messages received and Whirlwind will not be responsible for those charges if you sign up with your personal phone.

Facility Paging Systems

Each plant facility is equipped with a loud speaker paging system. These paging systems are in place to broadcast messages, give emergency instructions, or to locate employees in the plant. To send a page, dial the appropriate extension number, wait for the audible tone then speak.
